**RCW 84.56.020(10)** During a state of emergency declared under **RCW 43.06.010(12)**, the county treasurer, on his or her own motion or at the request of any taxpayer affected by the emergency, may grant extensions of the due date of any taxes payable under this section as the treasurer deems proper.

Pursuant to **RCW 84.56.020(10)**, on March 30th, 2020 the Spokane County Treasurer authorized an extension for the spring 2020 Spokane County property tax deadline from April 30<sup>th</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup>. On July 24th, 2020, the Governor issued proclamation 20-19.3 extending the statewide moratorium on evictions through October 15th, 2020. The Spokane County Treasurer the same date continued an extension of first half 2020 property taxes on residential rental properties unable to pay due to the proclamation until October 15th, 2020. For most taxpayers, first half property taxes were due June 15th.

I am the property owner/taxpayer on the above listed parcel(s). The above listed parcel(s) are residential rental properties in Spokane County. Due to the provisions of the Governor's 20-19.3 proclamation I am unable to pay the 2020 first half property taxes owed by June 15<sup>th</sup>.
