

Avista's Line Excess Allowance Program (LEAP)

Program ends February 28, 2019

If you're a Washington homeowner converting to natural gas, we have a program that may help you pay for the cost of purchasing and installing new natural gas equipment — no matter what fuel you're currently using to heat your home. This program is available to Avista's electric customers as well as homeowners who are not an Avista customer.

The Washington Line Excess Allowance Program (LEAP) provides residential customers with an "allowance" of \$4,678 to help pay for the cost of connecting to our natural gas system. If the cost to connect to our system is less than the allowance amount (of \$4,678), the excess remaining amount can be applied toward the purchase and installation of a new, high-efficient natural gas furnace or boiler; and/or a new natural gas water heater.

This three-year Pilot Program ends February 28, 2019.

Customers must request natural gas service by February 28, 2019 to be eligible.

Additionally customers could be qualified for energy efficiency rebates when converting to natural gas, including:

- \$1,200 rebate for converting an electric furnace to a natural gas furnace
- \$1,700 rebate for converting both your electric furnace and water heater to natural gas
- \$300 rebate on a new, high-efficiency natural gas furnace
- \$215 rebate on a natural gas tankless water heater
- \$60 rebate on a natural gas tank water heater
